Tender document can be downloaded from the website of http://eprocure.gov.in/eprocure/app or http://mpeda.gov.in. Dead line for submission of bid is 1400 hrs on 16/12/2021. The bids are required to be uploaded in two separate parts i.e. Technical bid & financial bid. The Technical bid will be opened at 1530 hrs. on 20/12/2021 at the MPEDA Head Office at the address given above. The financial bids of bidders whose Technical bids get qualified would be opened at a later date.

Introduction

The Marine Products Exports Development Authority (MPEDA) (hereinafter referred as 'MPEDA') is a statutory body under the Ministry of Commerce and Industry, Government of India. MPEDA with its Head office at Panampilly Nagar, Kochi is entrusted with the primary task of promotion of export of Fish and Fishery products from India.

MPEDA invites bids under two bids system from Authorized Class A ISPs for 100 Mbps (1:1) Leased Line Internet connection on Fiber at MPEA Head office premises.

B. SCOPE OF WORK

Scope of Work for 100 Mbps Internet Lease Line:

- 1. The leased line from category "A" ISP (license from Govt. of India) should only be commissioned.
- 2. 100 Mbps committed bandwidth at any point of the time.
- 3. Bidder should provide the tool to monitor the bandwidth / network performance
- 4. Bidder should not violate regulations as laid by Government of India / TRAI in respect of

- such links / networks.
- 5. Installation of 100 Mbps internet leased line is the sole responsibility of the vendor.
- 6. The proposed link to be terminated at the UTM available at MPEDA HO first floor.
- 7. Bidder should be responsible for provisioning end-to-end solution.
- 8. The successful bidder should be prepared to complete the installation and providing the services within 6 weeks from the date of issue of the purchase order.
- 9. The Successful bidder should have Toll Free number for fault registering within India and should provide support on 365 x 24 x 7 basis.
- 10. The successful bidder has to sign a service Level Agreement with MPEDA.
- 11. The Successful bidder should provide all necessary equipment for connectivity, if any.
- 12. The Successful bidder has to provide onsite support, when required Successful bidder has to mention the Escalation procedure and matrix for customer complaints.
- 13. The Successful bidder has to ensure minimum 99.5% uptime per month for the connectivity.
- 14. Any fault in the internet connectivity will need to be resolved by the vendor as per the following schedule:
 - a. On failure of fiber Link should be activated immediately
 - b. Uptime Calculation: Uptime shall be calculated as (Total Time Down Time) X 100/Total Time. Deduction in payment will be made for downtime in the quarterly bills raised by the ISP (service provider)
 - c. The response time for attending the faults will be 1 hour after reporting to the service provider. The service provider will rectify the faults within 12 hours failing which the vendor will arrange temporary replacements.
 - d. The services shall be provided 24 X 7 X365.
 - e. Downtime penalty in % on monthly basis
 - i. Actual Uptime >=99.5% No penalty
 - ii. Actual Uptime >= 99 to < 99.50 % 2%
 - iii. Actual Uptime >= 98.5 to < 99 % 5%
 - iv. Actual Uptime >= 98 to <98.5% 7%
 - v. Actual Uptime >= 95 to <98% 10%
 - vi. Actual Uptime >= 90 to <95% 20%
 - vii. Actual Uptime < 90% 50%

C. SUBMISSION OF BIDS

Bidders are advised to study the Bid document carefully. The bid along with the necessary documents should be submitted online through Central Public Procurement Portal (CPPP) website: https://eprocure.gov.in/eprocure/app (after log in to the portal using Digital Certificate) in two bid systems i.e. (i) technical bid and (ii) financial bid not later than the date and time specified in the Schedule. Prospective Bidders are advised to follow the instructions provided in the "General Instruction to Bidders" for e-submission of the bids online through CPPP for e-Procurement at https://eprocure.gov.in/eprocure/app. Bid documents may be scanned with 100 dpi with black and white option which helps in reducing size of the scanned document. Tender sent by any other mode will not be accepted. All bids must be accompanied with EMD declaration in the attached format.

D. THE OTHER TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF EVALUATION CRITERIA ARE AS UNDER:

- 1. The Tender Evaluation Committee may choose to conduct technical negotiation or discussion with any or all the Bidders. The decision of the Evaluation Committee in the evaluation of the Technical and Commercial bids shall be final and binding on all the parties.
- 2. Any effort by a Bidder to influence the Tender Evaluation Committee's processing of Bids or award decisions may result in the rejection of the Bid.
- 3. Failure of the Bidder to agree with the Terms & Conditions of the RFP/work order shall constitute sufficient grounds for the annulment of the award of order, in which event the order may be awarded to the next most responsive bidder.
- 4. Please note:
 - a. There should be no mention of prices in any part of the bid other than the financial bids.
 - b. Unit prices for each component of the financial proposal should be mentioned. Any spelling mistakes or incomplete information furnished would invite for a disqualification of the bid
 - c. In the commercial bid if there is any discrepancy between the prices mentioned in figures and in words, the prices mentioned in words/figures whichever is lower will prevail.
 - d. Substantially Responsible Bids: A substantially responsive Bid is one, which conforms to all the requirements, terms, conditions and specifications of the Request for Proposal.

E. AWARD OF ORDER

- 1. The order will be awarded to the bidder whose bid has been determined to be eligible and to be substantially responsive to the bid documents and who has offered the lowest evaluated bid.
- 2. The order will be for a period of 2 years initially and can be extended on year to year basis subject to mutual consent and continuous satisfactory performance.
- 3. MPEDA reserves the right to review the requirement before the expiry of 12 months depending upon the need for continuity, the performance of the ISP and extend the period further based on mutual consent.

F. OBLIGATION OF THE AGENCY

The successful bidder shall supply the uninterrupted 100 mbps (1:1) uncompressed and uninterrupted internet leased line and IP for use in MPEDA Head Office as per the requirements and specifications in this tender document.

G. PAYMENT

- 1. Bandwidth Charge: Annual Recurring (bandwidth) charges shall be payable on post quarterly basis at the end of the quarter after satisfactory delivery of services, for which the Service Provider will raise the bill at the end of each quarter.
- 2. Hardware Charges: All the hardware procured shall be maintained by the vendor at no

- additional charge for the entirety of the operation of service.
- 3. Charge for Dedicated Lease Line: Vendor (ISP) will be required to provide the bandwidth over wired media (OFC). No additional charges will be paid for the leased line
- 4. Penalty if any, shall be deducted from the quarterly bills
- 5. No interest will be paid for delayed payments
- 6. Payments will be made after deducting TDS on Income tax; GST as applicable.

H. TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- 1. The bidders will have to submit a Bid Security declaration in the attached format.
- 2. All entries in the tender form should be legible and filled clearly, if the space provided for furnishing is insufficient; a separate sheet duly signed by the authorized signatory may be scanned and uploaded. No correction in either the Technical Bids or Financial Bids is permitted.
- 3. Conditional bids shall not be considered and will be rejected summarily.
- 4. The Technical Bid shall be opened on the scheduled date and time 1530 hrs. on 13/12/2021 in MPEDA HO.
- 5. The Financial Bids of only those bidders who qualify in the technical bid will be opened after evaluation by the Committee constituted for the purpose.
- 6. Tender document should be signed on all the pages by the Authorized signatory along with seal of the firm.
- 7. No bidding firm will be allowed to withdraw its bids after technical bids have been opened.
- 8. The Secretary MPEDA reserves the right to reject any or all the tenders submitted by the bidders at any time or relax/withdraw/ add any of the terms and conditions contained in the Tender Documents without assigning any reason thereof.
- 9. The downloaded tender documents be from website can the https://eprocure.gov.in/eprocure/app also from the MPEDA and website:https://mpeda.gov.in.
- 10. Any subsequent Updates, Addendums, Corrigendum etc., if any will be published only on the website http://eprocure.gov.in/eprocure/app and/or https://mpeda.gov.in.
- 11. All bidders are required to regularly check the MPEDA website: https://mpeda.gov.inand e-procurement portal https://eprocure.gov.in/eprocure/app for any updates.
- 12. The bidders have to meet the expense for their visit to MPEDA for any purpose. No TA/DA will be provided.
- 13. All cases/proceedings relating to any dispute or claim arising out of or any case of performance of this contract shall be falling in proper court having jurisdiction in Ernakulam, Kerala.
- 14. In the event, the ISP's company or concerned division of the company is taken over/bought over by another company, all the obligations under the agreement with MPEDA shall be passed on to the new company/division for compliance by the new company.
- 15. The tenderer should strictly ensure **Covid 19 protocol** in work place. OMs/Guidelines issued by Local Body/State/Central Government may be followed by the Contractors/representatives/labourers etc.,

I. LIQUIDATED DAMAGES FOR DELAY

If the Internet Service provider fails to complete the execution of works or any section by the time for completion, within the relevant time prescribed, then the ISP shall pay liquidated damages to MPEDA at the rate of the 0.5 % of order value for per week of delay or part thereof subject to maximum of 5% of the order value. MPEDAmay, without prejudice to any other method of recovery, deduct the amount of such damages from any monies due or to become due to the Contractor. The payment or deduction of such damages shall not relieve the Contractor from his obligation to complete the Works, or from any other of his obligations and liabilities under the contract.

J. INDEMNITY

The bidder shall indemnify and keep indemnified MPEDA against all losses and claims for injuries and damages to any person or property whatsoever which may arise out of or in consequence of the work and against all claims, demands, proceedings, damages, costs, changes, expenses whatsoever in respect thereof in relation thereto.

K. RIGHT TO TERMINATION

- 1. In case, the service provider does not provide the service of internet connectivity to MPEDA HO/ fulfill the requirement satisfactorily as per the requirements MPEDA or / and as per the Schedule of Requirements.
- 2. In case, the service provider goes bankrupt and becomes insolvent
- 3. In case breach of any terms and conditions of the tender document by the service provider, MPEDA shall have the right to cancel the order without assigning any reasons thereof.
