MPEDA Seafood Inquiry Chatbot Innovation Challenge: Guidelines

1. Registration Process:

- Each college can register three teams consisting of 5 members in each team. The team should have one designated leader, who will be the Single Point Of Contact (SPOC)
- Those colleges with more than three teams interested in the challenge can conduct an internal challenge and select the winning teams, who can participate in MPEDA challenge.
- Registration can be done by filling out a Google form available on the MPEDA website with basic details along with submission of a declaration by the engineering college via email to pub@mpeda.gov.in

2. Team Composition:

- Each team must have:
 - o One designated team leader.
 - o All students should be from the same college

3. Demonstrative Model Presentation:

- Each team is required to develop a demonstrative model of the Seafood Inquiry Chatbot.
- Teams can present their models to MPEDA in online mode. The presentation should demonstrate the functionality, efficiency, and innovation of their chatbot solution.

4. Prizes

- First Prize- Rs. 7 lakh
- Second Prize- Rs.3 lakh
- Third Prize-Rs.2 lakh
- Certificate of Participation- to all the registered participants who have submitted the project as per the conditions in clause 5.

The prize money, after deducting applicable taxes, will be transferred directly into the team leader's account.

The prize money will be given after successful integration of the AI-driven chatbot on the MPEDA platform.

5. What to submit

- *Include a URL to a prototype or application.*
- The source code of the AI-driven chatbot shall be submitted to MPEDA.
- The copyright of the prize winner and participants shall be vested with MPEDA.
- Include a text description explaining the features, functionality, and future development plans.
- Include a 2-minute demonstration video.

6. Evaluation and Judgment:

• A panel of IT specialists and experts selected by MPEDA will evaluate the chatbot solutions.

• Evaluation criteria will include creativity, technical proficiency, user friendliness, and the potential impact of the solution in addressing the issues raised in the problem statement.
