B. Selection Process

The selection process consists of a written test, presentation and personal interaction.

The weightage for the written Examination is 80% and the Presentation & personal interaction is 20%.

The written test, presentation and personal interaction are scheduled on **29.02.2024** at **9.00 A.M.** onwards. Candidates must report at **08.00 A.M.** at the venue for certificate verification.

Instructions:

- 1. Each Multiple-Choice Question (MCQ) carries 1 mark. In case of a wrong answer, 0.25 marks will be deducted for each wrong answer.
- 2. The candidates will also be requested to make a presentation on a topic for 5 minutes. The printout of the slides will be given in advance to the candidates on the day of the written test, for preparation.
- 3. Candidates must carry the Original Certificates to prove their identity (preferably an Aadhaar Card), educational qualification, experience, age, and caste (If age relaxation is claimed) for verification. Those who produce the original certificates will only be admitted to the selection process.
- 4. Any experience gained after the prescribed educational qualification mentioned in the notification will only be taken into consideration.
- 5. Candidates are advised to come prepared for an overnight stay in Kochi and schedule their departure from Kochi the next day afternoon, since the selection process may be prolonged according to the number of candidates.

- 6. MPEDA may verify the antecedents and documents submitted by a candidate during the tenure of his/her service. In case, it is detected that the documents submitted by the candidate are fake or the candidate has a clandestine antecedents/background and has suppressed any information, then his/her service shall be terminated and legal action may also be initiated against such candidates.
- 7. Candidates will be shortlisted for the Selection Process on the basis of the information provided by them in their online applications. They must ensure that such information is true. If at any subsequent stage or at the time of the test /interview any information given by them or any claim made by them in their online application is found to be false, their candidature will be liable to be rejected.
